A reminder of why we're here today...

- It's about trans-disciplinary approaches towards solving today's critical global health challenges. And the links between human, animal and environmental health
- The global food system is one of the largest drivers of climate change, nature loss and poor health. It accounts for around **25-30% of all GHG emissions and** causes **1 in 5 deaths globally.**
- Not only is it GHG emissions and deforestation (Land use change), but also freshwater use, eutrophication of waterways, and biodiversity loss.
- **6% of GHG emissions relate to food waste**. (**9 million tonnes** in the UK alone), yet in areas like Bradford, over **20% of people experience food insecurity**.

Fruitful Bradford


