# Nourishing Communities Vouchers Scheme

#FoodforHealthnotWealth





This scheme is designed to assist families experiencing food poverty by providing vouchers that can be redeemed for fresh, nutritious food at Darley Street Market and other participating outlets.

More than a short-term response, the scheme adopts a cash-first approach

Improve access to affordable, fresh, and nutritious food.

Promote healthy eating habits and food literacy.

Increase local economic activity.

Connecting communities with wider wellbeing services.

HOUSEHOLD SIZE	1	2	3	4	5+
Value of Vouchers	£10	£15	£20	£25	£30

Vouchers can be collected weekly for a period of three months, with an extension for up to three more months.







## **Essential Criteria**

- Live in Bradford Metropolitan District.
- Have not received food vouchers from this scheme in the past six months.

### At least one of:

- Households experiencing food insecurity due to low income.
- Families with children under 16 years old living in absolute or relative poverty.
- Individuals with no resources to public funds.

## **Prioritise**

- Asylum Seekers and refugees.
- People who experience severe mental health issues where food insecurity is a real risk.
- Residents of high-deprivation areas.
- Individuals requiring culturally appropriate food.



### THE REFERRAL PROCESS

- Initial assessment.
- 2. Explain the voucher scheme.
- 3. Data protection and family agreement.
- 4. Complete the referral form/ survey.
- 5. Voucher issue.
- 6. Follow-up.
- 7. Feedbacks.
